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**SPECIAL APPEAL FOR FEBRUARY** is designated for the Brown Bag Program. Each month volunteers mostly from our area Lutheran churches, package and deliver more than 400 boxes of staple food to individuals/ families identified and screened by various county agencies (e.g. Office for Mental Health/Mental Retardation, etc.) Food is purchased from the 3 Central PA Food Bank. The Brown Bag Program is also partially funded by the Franklin-Fulton County Chapter of Thrivent Financial for Lutherans. **SOUP AND SPIRIT LENTEN GATHERINGS** - On Wednesday evenings in Lent we will have our "Soup and Spirit" gatherings. Beginning February 17 thru March 16th, we will offer a simple meal of soup and bread at 5:30 p.m. (If you need other food for dietary reasons, you are welcome to bring your own food.) Following the meal we will have informal worship service and discussion. **If you plan to attend, please sign the sheet on the bulletin board in the vestibule.**

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**Our next TELL meeting is scheduled for Feb 21.** Last year, the youth selected many activities that they wanted to do as a group and bowling was one of these activities. We have lanes reserved at Sunshine Lanes from 2-4. Families and friends are invited. The churches will pay for the TELL members. For all others, the cost is \$6 per person which includes shoes and 2 games. Bumpers in the lanes are available. So we have enough lanes reserved, please RSVP the number of bowlers from your family including your TELL youth.

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**The TELL youth group** (Ages K-5<sup>th</sup> grade from ELC and Trinity) will be participating in the Souper Bowl of Caring. The Souper Bowl of Caring is youth across the nation working to fight hunger and poverty in their own communities around the time of the Super Bowl football game. The TELL group set a goal of trying to collect 500 cans and \$500 on monetary donations. Donations will be given to the local Food Bank housed at the Presbyterian Church. If you would like to help support the TELL group with this project please bring in any canned food items and deliver them to the display table in the narthex. Monetary donations can be put in the offering plate or given to the church office. Please write food donation/TELL on the memo line. We will be collecting donations through Sunday February 21.
