Dear Family in Christ,

It is difficult to wrap my head around the fact that Ash Wednesday is but a few weeks away. Yes. Ash Wednesday this year is on February 14. With Ash Wednesday Lent will begin. Lent is 40 days not counting Sundays. Why don't we count Sundays? Each Sunday marks the resurrection of Jesus. We still observe 6 Sundays in Lent. The last will be Passion/Palm Sunday.

Lent is a solemn time in which we consider the words that we hear on Ash Wednesday, "Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return." We are reminded of the fragile nature of our existence. We are reminded of the sinful nature of humankind, of our own sins and that the only way that we can be saved is not through our own works but through the salvific life and death of Jesus our Lord. It is a time to reflect on that and how we still have moments when we fall into sin and how we still need the washing of daily repentance. Lent is a good time, a spiritual time. It is a time to reflect on our lives as Christians and how we can draw ever closer to God and to one another.

I am pleased to say that we will not be observing our Lenten journey alone. I met with the interim pastor at Evangelical Lutheran Church, Pastor Katy Yates Brungraber, and we have put together a plan for observing Ash Wednesday, Lent and Holy Week. We look forward to this time of fellowship, friendship and spiritual deepening as we walk with Jesus in his journey to Jerusalem. All of this is in preparation for what is to come at the end of March. So prepare yourselves. Get ready, because here we go.

WORDS FOR WORSHIP

It is common for us to prepare ourselves and our worship for the Lenten fast, by the custom to "bury" the Alleluia. Alleluia is our special "party" word, used to remind us of heaven, and the resurrection of Jesus Christ which gives us life eternal. It is a happy word meaning "Praise Yahweh" and while we always give praise to God, in Lent we refrain from the boisterous, rousing Alleluia, and our worship becomes more reflective, and reminds us of our own sinfulness. Lenten season is a reminder of Jesus and his journey to Jerusalem, his trial, suffering and death all so that our sins would be forgiven. So, from Ash Wednesday through the Vigil of Easter we refrain from using alleluia. The tradition of putting away or burying the Alleluia goes back centuries and for us it is a visible reminder that we are entering into the season of Lent, a time to take stock of our lives and especially to take stock of all that God has done for us in Christ.

Alleluia will be back on Easter Sunday when we celebrate with great joy the resurrection of our Lord Jesus. Easter worship will be more meaningful for having gone without alleluia for a while. In the meantime, with great vigor we sing alleluia until it is deposited away for a time.


PLAN NOW TO ATTEND ON THE WEDNESDAYS IN LENT
