Family in Christ,

Ascension Day is upon us, and then Pentecost. These are key days in the life of the church. Ascension Day, because it falls during the week, we rarely celebrate, and yet, it is a day of meaning for the people of the faith and for the church. It is the day that our Lord Jesus, left the earth and took his seat at the right hand of God in heaven.

Pentecost is the day that the Holy Spirit was given to the church and all of the baptized. It is sometimes called the birthday of the church. The giving of the Spirit is important to us, because the Spirit is the one that "Calls, gathers, enlightens and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth" (*Small Catechism*). It is through the Spirit that Jesus is present with us in our worship and is truly present in the bread and wine of communion.

We are not alone, so long as we believe that Jesus is present with us still. Ascended, and yet in the Spirit is present with us anyway. It is one of the mysteries of our faith.

With the coming of Pentecost, the season of Easter concludes, but Christ the crucified and risen one is with us still. Each Sunday is a resurrection day, a time to remember the one who gives us eternal life. A time to celebrate the precious gifts of God.



We ended up with a total of 13 donors and from them we were able to collect 11 pints of blood. This collection will help us save the lives of up to 33 local patients! With every pint we collect, we are able to separate the pint into 3 components; platelets, red blood cells, and plasma. Each component can essentially be used in 3 different patients depending on the patient's needs. This is where we get the 33 lives saved.

It was a first attempt for us with Central PA Blood Bank. As well, they are new to this area and still building a client base, so this was a good first try.
