

¹ Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God. ³ And not only that, but we also boast in our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, ⁴ and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, ⁵ and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us. *The Holy Gospel according to John, the sixteenth chapter. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

*Gospel: John 16:12-15

[Jesus said,] ¹² "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. ¹³ When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own but will speak whatever he hears, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify me because he will take what is mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵ All that the Father has is mine. For this reason I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you."

Children's Message Sermon **Time of Silence:** Let us respond to God's Word and God's love for us by becoming still, closing our eyes and opening our hearts to God's presence.

Hymn

Holy God, We Praise Your Name (ELW #414) vs 1-4

Athanasian Creed – (abridged)

L: This is the catholic faith: We worship one God in trinity and the Trinity in unity, neither confusing the persons nor dividing the divine being.

C: For the Father is one person, the Son is another, and the Spirit is still another.

L: But the deity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one, equal in glory, coeternal in majesty.

C: What the Father is, the Son is, and so is the Holy Spirit.

L: Uncreated is the Father; uncreated is the Son; uncreated is the Spirit.

C: The Father is infinite; the Son is infinite; The Holy Spirit is infinite.

L: Eternal is the Father; eternal is the Son; eternal is the Spirit;

C: And yet there are not three eternal beings, but one who is eternal; as there are not three uncreated and unlimited beings but one who is uncreated and unlimited.

L: Almighty is the Father; almighty is the Son; almighty is the Spirit;

C: And yet there are not three almighty beings, but one who is almighty.

L: Thus the Father is God; the Son is God; the Holy Spirit is God:

C: And yet there are not three gods, but one God.

L: The Father is Lord; the Son is Lord; the Holy Spirit is Lord.

C: and yet there are not three lords, but one Lord.

L: And in this Trinity, no one is before or after, greater or less than the other; but all three are in themselves coeternal and coequal;

C: and so we must worship the Trinity in unity and the one God in three persons.

L: It is necessary for eternal salvation that one also faithfully believe that our Lord Jesus Christ became flesh. For this is the true faith that we believe and confess: That our Lord Jesus Christ, God's Son, is both God and man, existing fully as God, and fully as man with a rational soul and a human body; equal to the Father in divinity, subordinate to the Father in humanity.

C: Although he is God and man, he is not divided, but is one Christ.

L: He suffered death for our salvation.

C: He descended into hell and rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. This is the catholic faith.


***Offertory Prayer**
