## Liturgical Matters

**Shrovetide** is the liturgical period in the church that immediately precedes Lent. It encompasses Shrove Sunday, Shrove Monday and Shrove Tuesday and the festive Carnival of the same period.

The word **shrove** comes from the word *shrive* meaning to pass judgement, or to pronounce absolution. Shrovetide is the time to prepare ourselves body and soul for the Lenten Fast. It is a time in which Christians attempt to use up all of the eggs, dairy, and any fats prior to the fasting period of Lent. The Pennsylvania Germans make *Fastnachts* or a doughnut, the Polish make *Paczki* a rich doughnut filled with jams or custards. The English make pancakes as do people of the United States. In Denmark they consume *fastelavnsboller* or small round cakes filled with almond paste, jam, or cream.

The whole point of the season is to prepare oneself spiritually for Lent by examining one's conscience, making confession and receiving the absolution, and by preparing our bodies for fasting at Lent. It is also the time to consider what you might give up for Lent. Some suggest chocolate and others overeating, but perhaps we might give up trying to control everything, or being angry, or giving up hope. Maybe instead of giving up something we should consider taking up something like almsgiving, prayer, making the world a better place. What will you do for

4. Use the QR code found in your pew and follow the prompts to make donations via *credit card*.
